**Component :**      **BrowserRedirect**

**Description :**      This is a component from my Script-Component-Collection. With this component you can build a browser-specific-redirect page. The component has the ability to specify many different browsers. The function-name has to be unique for the page. If a function-name is not inserted, a unique standard-name will be used. You can choose to call the code automatically or manually, as needed.

<u>Properties</u>	<u>Description</u>
• <b>Wizard :</b>	Double-Click this property to open the wizard or choose the Wizard-Tab you want to see first.
• <b>Function-Name :</b> <b>(optional)</b>	Here you enter the name for the JavaScript function. The name will be used to call the function. The name must be <b>unique</b> for this page. You will need this name when choosing to call the function manually. When left empty, a default-name will be used.
• <b>Call-Type :</b>	Choose how to call the function : manually or automatically.
• <b>Default :</b> <b>(optional)</b>	This link will be used if no other link is found.
• <b>Use in Frames :</b>	With this property you choose if you want to link to Autoframe-pages. In this case and according to the entered link target some NOF-Autoframe-specific things will be generated.
• <b>Link Target :</b> <b>(optional)</b>	Here you enter the name for the frame or window where the resulting page will be displayed.
• <b>... :</b> <b>(optional)</b>	With all the next URLs you can choose which page the user will be redirected to with a specific browser.
• <b>Other Browser :</b> <b>(optional)</b>	This link will be used if the browser is neither Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator/Communicator.
• <b>Use Custom-HTML :</b>	Here you choose if the Custom-HTML entered in the Wizard is inserted when publishing or not.
